There are views of Mt Gnomon and Mt Duncan and sea glimpses from higher parts of the paddocks. A natural rocky outcrop in the Southwestern Corner provides incredible sea views.

Every paddock is serviced by water and fences were upgraded only three years ago.

The home is a charming post-war build with 4 bedrooms, modern kitchen, bathroom and separate living areas.
